METHADONE PROGRAMS

Methadone is a well-tested medication that is safe for the treatment of narcotic withdrawal and dependence, and is mostly used for those suffering from opioid addiction. Most centers offer dosing in the mornings so clients can get to work on time. The medication is active for up to twenty-four hours. Below is a list of such programs.
