- * Must generally be less than \$2000
 - * Households with at least one member age 60 or older may have assets up to \$3000
 - * Categorically eligible households do not have an asset limit
- Household income must be within 130% of Federal Poverty Level.

FoodShare benefits can be used for food and for plants and seeds for home food gardens, but may not be used for alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, pet food, soap or paper products, or any other non-food items.
