The FoodShare Program provides persons and families who have little money or savings to buy the food they need for good health. Most grocery stores participate in the program.

An eligible individual must:

- \* Be a citizen or eligible alien
- \* Be willing to register for work unless exempt.

Household assets:

- \* Must generally be less than \$2000
- \* Households with at least one member age 60 or older may have assets up to \$3000
- \* Categorically eligible households do not have an asset limit

Household income must be within 130% of Federal Poverty Level.

FoodShare benefits can be used for food and for plants and seeds for home food gardens, but may not be used for alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, pet food, soap or paper products, or any other non-food items.
