David had been homeless due to his drug and alcohol addictions. After receiving treatment at Alcocare, he had no where to live and no job.

In 2008, David moved into an apartment provided by The Salvation Army's Pathways Transitional Housing Program. Pathways is providing the stable housing and support he needs to reach his goal of self-sufficiency.

David now works 32+ hours a week, pays his rent on time each month and is saving to purchase a car. He's also planning goals which include permanent housing and different career options. He even gives back to the community by volunteering one night a week at the GIFTS Shelter for homeless men.
